



Why join the Los Angeles Figure Skating Club?

A U.S. Figure Skating Basic Skills membership allows skaters to participate in learn-to-skate activities sponsored by the program and also in Basic Skills competitions. However, to participate in all U.S. Figure Skating activities, skaters must become a FULL member of U.S. Figure Skating, either with an affiliated club, like the Los Angeles Figure Skating Club or as an individual member. The Los Angeles Figure Skating Club has been in existence since 1933, and is one of the most prestigious clubs in the country.

When should you join The Los Angeles Figure Skating Club?

Once your child is ready to take official U.S. Figure Skating tests or participate in competitions beyond the Basic Skills level, it is time to join the Los Angeles Figure Skating Club, which operates out of East West Ice Palace, & Pickwick Ice Center and is the home club to many past world and Olympic medalists, including Michelle Kwan.

What activities do we provide?

Aside from social events like picnics and parties, we offer club sessions, ice shows, recitals, competitions, critiques and monthly test sessions. In order for your child to take skating skills tests or compete in U.S. Figure Skating sanctioned competitions, he/she must be a FULL member of U.S. Figure Skating. By becoming a Los Angeles Figure Skating Club member, your skater will receive special discounts on sponsored test sessions, and will be able to participate in our shows, exhibitions, and other events. We also provide a mentoring program that gives interested adults the support and training they need to become U.S. Figure Skating judges.

What additional benefits are provided?

As part of your FULL membership to U.S. Figure Skating you are entitled to the following: certificates of accomplishment for passing proficiency tests and placing at U.S. Figure Skating qualifying events (athletes); subscription to SKATING magazine; individually numbered membership card; coverage under U.S. Figure Skating's sports accident insurance policy; memories to last a lifetime!



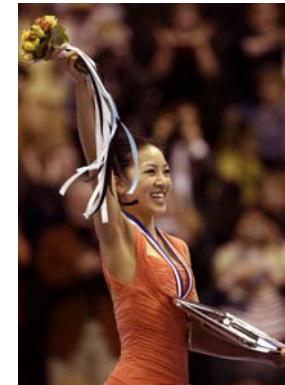

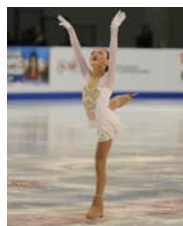

ABOUT US:

The Los Angeles Figure Skating Club, founded in 1933, is a member of U.S. Figure Skating. Home to more than 70 National, World and Olympic Champions, the Club is one of the largest and most notable in the United States.

Our home rink – Pickwick Ice Center in Burbank, California – hosts a thriving community of skaters and their families. We also have a presence at the East West Ice Palace in Artesia, California, and Iceland in Van Nuys. We sponsor four major competitions each year: The Adult Mid-Winter Open Championships in February, The California Championships in May, The Los Angeles Open Championships in July, and the ground-breaking theatrical skating competition, LAFSC Showcase for Skaters in June. Additionally, we promote Theatre On Ice, offer critiques to our competitive skaters and sponsor exhibitions. We have opportunities for judges, coaches, skaters, and parents to learn the nuances of our sport, and we offer a complete program of U.S. Figure Skating tests. At the grass roots level, we sponsor occasional Parents' Seminars to help those who are new to skating to understand what it is all about.

The Los Angeles Figure Skating Club is a private, not-for-profit organization and membership is available to anyone who meets our eligibility criteria. We pride ourselves on being a family-oriented club where we celebrate all of our members' achievements and encourage a team atmosphere. Membership Categories:

Bridge Membership – \$30

Qualification Criteria: For individual skaters who are registered Basic Skills members and are planning to test and/or compete at any and all USFS levels. Applicants must provide a Basic Skills registration number to be eligible. You may utilize this membership once. Successive memberships will be renewed at the regular membership rate.

Introductory Membership - \$50.00

First time/one-time only membership for individual skaters who have never been members of USFS and plan on testing and/or competing at any and all USFS levels. Additional introductory family members can join for additional \$38.00 each. All successive memberships will be renewed at the regular First Family Home Club or Second Family membership rate.

Regular First Family Home Club Membership – \$95.00

Membership for individual skaters who test and/or compete at any and all USFS levels. Additional family members may renew/join at \$60.00 per person.

Second Club Membership – \$50

Membership for individual skaters who test and/or compete at any and all USFS levels and belong to a home club other than LAFSC. Additional family members may renew/join at \$50.00 per person.

Associate Membership – \$20

For persons who do not skate but who wish to support LAFSC and US Figure Skating in honor of a particular skater. This membership category does not include a U.S. Figure Skating membership.

Collegiate Membership: \$105.00

A 4 year membership for those of you going to college. The cost for the entire four year period is \$105.00. It entitles you to all the same benefits of a regular membership. Proof of college enrollment is required. The subsequent three years of your membership with US Figure Skating and LAFSC will automatically be renewed with no additional charges to you. After the four years has elapsed you will then have to renew your membership with the LAFSC and US Figure Skating at the Regular Home Club Membership rate.
